WHO WE ARE: Omega Phi Beta Foundation (OPBF) is a national philanthropic organization committed to providing leadership, academic, and community development opportunities through educational and grant-making initiatives. These initiatives support individuals and organizations dedicated to advancing women's rights in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, & Math).

BE A RISING BUD: The Omega Phi Beta Foundation Rising Bud Scholarship is awarded to current high-school seniors pursuing a degree in the **ART** fields listed below. Our goal is to help lower the financial burden of tuition and encourage girls to expand their creative abilities.

Studies for consideration include:

- **Applied Arts** (Creative Literature/Writing, Decorative Art, Design, Fashion Design, Fine Arts, Graphic Design, Industrial Design)
- **Cinematic Arts** (Animation, Audio/Sound, Film-Making)
- **Performing Arts** (Dance, Music, Step, Theater)
- **Visual Arts** (Animation, Architecture, Audio/Sound, Ceramics, Computer Art, Crafts, Design, Drawing, Filmmaking, Illustration, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Video, Visual Communications)

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must currently be a female high-school senior.
- Must be in pursuit of an undergraduate degree at a college or university.
- Must be from a low income household earning a combined income that is less than \$45,000.00 a year.
- Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in one of the areas listed below:
 - **Applied Arts** (Creative Literature/Writing, Decorative Art, Design, Fashion Design, Fine Arts, Graphic Design, Industrial Design)
 - **Cinematic Arts** (Animation, Audio/Sound, Film-Making)
 - **Performing Arts** (Dance, Music, Step, Theater)
 - **Visual Arts** (Animation, Architecture, Audio/Sound, Ceramics, Computer Art, Crafts, Design, Drawing, Filmmaking, Illustration, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Video, Visual Communications)

SELECTION PROCESS: The Board of Directors of Omega Phi Beta Foundation will review and consider all applicants.

AWARD INFORMATION: All General Scholarships are awarded for one year only and are non-renewable. Individual scholarship awards are for \$500.00.

AWARD NOTIFICATION: Any student selected to receive a scholarship will be notified via e-mail.



HOW TO APPLY:

1. Submit a completed general application (see page 3).
2. Current official high-school transcript.
3. Proof of Fall 2019 or Spring 2020 enrollment in an accredited university or college.
4. Three (3) Letters of Recommendation. One recommendation must be from current member in the field of choice, such as a mentor, teacher, or advisor.

Letters of recommendation must include the following:

1. Applicant's name and level of study
2. Name of school or program of study
3. Complete address, phone and/or fax, and email address of the school or nominator

NOTE: Letters of recommendation must be sent via e-mail as an attached PDF file. All the letters must be sent by the recommender submitting the recommendation on the student's behalf. The letters must be received on or before the scholarship deadlines noted herein. **It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all letters are sent by the deadline.**

5. Personal Statement – Submit a personal statement of 350-500 words in PDF format. Please submit your personal statement using the following questions as guidelines:
 - What sparked your interest in your chosen arts field?
 - What are your career goals?
 - Describe your experience in the field. For example, have you participated in any exhibitions? Did you get your start in dance as a child? What led you to writing?
 - Please make sure you include the information requested for your selected media entry, as described on the [Media Submission Format Guidelines](#).
6. Submit copy of parent or guardian's previous tax return making sure to cross out any sensitive information, such as social security number.
7. Submit a piece of original work using criteria as outlined on the [Media Submission Format Guidelines](#) page.
8. A clear headshot of yourself in either .JPG or .GIF format, which will be used on our social media if you are chosen as the winner.
9. A signed Photo Release Form (found on page 4).
